3. Data regarding Sanctioned Faculty strength also showed discrepancy
4. Only State and National Awards given by government/recognized bodies should be mentioned
5. The Institution only caters to Undergraduate programmes
6. There were nil enrolments of students from ST and PwD category.

REPORT OF NATIONAL SEMINAR ON 'PROTECTING AND ASSESSING THE INNOVATIVE ECOSYSTEMS'

ORGANISED BY IQAC AND UNDER THE AEGIS OF DBT STAR COLLEGE SCHEME

6-7, JANUARY, 2020

The two day National Seminar was organized in 6 sessions, followed by meeting of the Mentee Institutions under UGC-PARAMARSH. The speakers on the first day included Dr. Prosenjit Chattopadhyay Dr. Parul Varshney Mr. Pulkit Doger Mr. Raghav Sarma and on the second day Dr. Pratibha Singh and Dr. Kumar Karitkey Yadav.

Dr Parul Varshney while speaking on PATENTS explained about drafting of patent application in various fields of chemistry, patentability searches, and patent prosecution of foreign Applications.

Dr Pulkit Doger addressed the gathering regarding PATENT PROSECUTION. He explained about drafting and prosecution of patent applications relating to the fields of mechanical engineering, software, electrical engineering, biomedical devices, telecommunication engineering, and automobile engineering. He also spoke about drafting patent specification for India as well as foreign jurisdictions, and prosecuting Indian and foreign patent applications

Dr. Prosenjit Chattopadhyay discussed the drafting, prosecution of patent application in various fields of chemistry, biotechnology, pharmaceuticals, oil and gas.

Mr Raghav Sarma defined the various processes in drafting and prosecuting of patent applications for inventions in software, telecommunication, electronics and electrical engineering

Dr. Pratibha Singh spoke about the changes made in SSR 7 criterion from qualitative to quantitative, weightage for key indicators under 7 criterion, online survey form for students, online dashboard for educational institutions to upload data of SSR from and third party evaluation of SSR for with the help of Artificial intelligence to mark qualitative and quantitative information provided by the concern institutions for their accreditation and assessment.

Dr. Kumar Karitkey Yadav spoke about the benefits and problems of Plagiarism in academic research. He also explained the ways to overcome from the problems of plagiarism to the teachers who are working on different working papers in their fields. He discussed the consequences of the Plagiarism, if not verify in case of publication of research papers.
